# **DALE COUNTY JAIL PAINTING SPECIFICATIONS**

Price to include all insurance, licenses, materials, and labor to complete job.

Proof of all licenses, workers' compensation and liability coverage to be submitted with the bid.

One (1) year warranty of all work performed is required.

Paint to include an additive for mold prevention.

## **Section 1:**

Dale County Jail - Front area up until the entrance of the cell block area.

### **Scope of Work:**

Mechanically grind all floor in women's area, women's common area, holding cells, and trustee area.

Apply new epoxy floor coating per Sherwin Williams specifications.

All walks, doors, ceilings, and miscellaneous windows to be cleaned, prepped, and painted new brown color picked by County.

All work to be done within the Jail's schedule.

All work to follow Sherwin Williams specifications.

## **Section 2:**

Dale County Jail – Cell block area.

### **Scope of Work:**

All painted floors in cell blocks to be mechanically grinded to remove existing coating to bare concrete. After removal, apply two coats of Armorseal 8100 to all floors receiving paint. Color to be picked by County.

All walls in common areas, cell block areas, cells, and guard areas to be cleaned and painted with water-based epoxy per Sherwin Williams specifications. all ceilings to receive Pro Mar 400 Flat.

All metal doors, handrails, guard rails on balcony, metal cell grates, cell doors, and regular doors to received two coats of MacroEpoxy 646. All metal will receive this system,
