PROCEEDINGS PERTAINING TO THE REQUEST FOR
AND CALL OF A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR RENEWAL AND
CONTINUATION OF THE LEVY OF THE 4 MILL
COUNTYWIDE SCHOOL TAX IN DALE COUNTY
(Amendment No. 3, Section 1, Constitution of Alabama of 1901)

The following resolution and order was introduced in writing by Commissioner

McKinon :

BE IT RESOLVED, ORDERED AND DECREED by the Dale County
Commission (herein called "the Commission") as follows:

Section 1. Findings. (a) The Commission hereby finds, determines and
declares that there has been filed with the Commission a petition in writing signed by 200 or
more qualified electors of the County which petition (except for the signatures) is in words and
figures as follows:

TO THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF DALE COUNTY, ALABAMA:

*We, the undersigned qualified electors of Dale County, Alabama, hereby petition
and request that you call and cause to be held a special election at the several regularly
established voting places in the said County on January 11, 2022, between the legal hours for
holding elections, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the said County the question of
whether it shall be authorized to renew and continue the annual levy, for a period of 30
consecutive years commencing with the levy for the tax year that will begin on October 1, 2022
(for which first tax year taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2023), of a special ad
valorem tax for public school purposes in said County at the rate of 4 mills on each dollar (or
\$.40 on each \$100) of the assessed value of taxable property in said County, being the tax that
was originally authorized and provided for in Section 1 of Amendment No. 3 to the Constitution
of Alabama of 1901 and the rate of which was heretofore increased pursuant to proceedings
taken under the said Constitution, it being intended that the said special tax to be voted on at the
said election shall constitute a renewal and continuation of the said tax and shall not constitute
an increase in the rate of taxation presently authorized in the County.*

(End of Petition)

The Commission has caused the signatures that were signed to the said petition to be carefully checked as to their authenticity and the names of the signers of the said petition to be checked against the roll of the qualified electors of Dale County and the Commission has determined that the said petition was signed by more than 200 persons who are duly qualified electors of the County.

(b) The Commission hereby further finds, determines and declares that said petition complies in all respects with the applicable provisions of Article 9 of Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Code of Alabama 1975, except that the Commission has been advised that the requested duration of the levy (viz., for 30 consecutive years), exceeds the allowable time as set out in section 16-13-108 of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, and that it will be appropriate and consistent with said section 16-13-108 for the ballot relating to the renewal and continuation of the said tax be prepared in such a manner that a favorable result would not cause the tax to become due and payable later than 30 years from the October 1 next after the date set for the said election.

Section 2. Call of Election. An election shall be and hereby is called to be held in the County on January 11, 2022, between the legal hours for holding elections and at the regular voting places in the County, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the County the question of whether it shall be authorized to renew and continue the annual levy, for a period of twenty-nine (29) consecutive years beginning with the levy for the tax year that will begin on October 1, 2022 (for which first tax year taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2023), of a special ad valorem tax for public school purposes in the County at the rate of 4 mills on each dollar (or \$.40 on each \$100) of the assessed value of taxable property in said County, being the tax that was originally authorized and provided for in Section 1 of Amendment No. 3 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 and the rate of which was heretofore increased pursuant to proceedings taken under the said Constitution; it being intended that the said special tax to be voted on at the said election shall constitute a renewal and continuation of the said tax and shall not constitute an increase in the rate of taxation presently authorized in the County.

Section 3. Voting Places. The said election called shall be held and conducted at the regularly established voting places in the County except as to the casting of ballots of absent voters as hereinafter provided.

Section 4. Notice of Election. The sheriff of the County is hereby directed to give notice of the said election in the manner prescribed by law, by publication in *The Southern Star*, a newspaper published and having general circulation in the County, once a week for four consecutive weeks prior to the date fixed for said election, the first publication of such notice to be at least thirty days before the election. The said notice to be so published shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR
RENEWAL AND CONTINUATION OF THE

(Amendment No. 3, Section 1, Constitution of Alabama of 1901)

Notice is hereby given that the Dale County Commission has called and ordered a special election to be held in Dale County on January 11, 2022, at which there will be submitted to the qualified electors of said County, for their determination by ballot, the question of whether the said County shall be authorized to levy annually, for a period of twenty-nine (29) successive years, commencing with the levy for the tax year that will begin on October 1, 2022 (for which tax year taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2023), for public school purposes in said County, a special property or ad valorem tax at the rate of forty cents on each one hundred dollars (equal to 4 mills on each dollar) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property in the said County. If the said special tax is authorized at the said election, its levy will not increase the rate of taxation presently levied in the County but will constitute a renewal and continuation of the special tax at the same rate and for the same purpose now being levied in the County.

The said election will be held at the regularly established voting places in said County between the legal hours for holding elections.

Section 5. Form of Ballot. The form of the official ballot to be used at the said election shall be in substantially the following form, except that there shall appear on the envelope accompanying each ballot for absent voters an affidavit substantially equivalent to the applicable form of affidavit prescribed for absent voters by law:

January 11, 2022

Shall the governing body of Dale County, Alabama, be authorized to levy annually, for a period of twenty-nine (29) successive years, commencing with the levy for the tax year that will begin on October 1, 2022 (for which tax year taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2023), for public school purposes in said county, a special property tax at the rate of forty cents on each one hundred dollars (equal to 4 mills on each dollar) of the assessed value of the taxable property in said county, which special tax shall be in renewal and continuation of the special tax at the same rate and for the same purpose that is now being levied in the said county?

() FOR proposed taxation

() AGAINST proposed taxation

The voter shall make a cross mark (X) before the proposition that expresses his or her choice.

Section 6. Ballots for Absent Voters. The form of the ballots for absent voters to be cast at the election shall be the same as that provided above except as follows:

- (a) In lieu of the words "Official Ballot" at the heading of the ballot there shall be substituted the words "Official Absentee Ballot";
- (b) In lieu of the instructions to voters appearing at the end of the Official Ballot there shall be substituted the following:

Instructions to Voters

The voter shall record his or her choice, whether for or against the said special tax, by placing a cross mark before or after the words expressing his or her choice.

(c) Each absentee ballot shall be accompanied by an envelope on which there shall be printed an affidavit in the form prescribed by law for absent voters for elections held in this state.

Section 7. Election Officers. The special election to be held in the County on January 11, 2022, shall be held and the results of such election shall be declared in the same manner and by the same officers as the results of regular elections for county officers, under the general election laws of the state.

Commissioner Carroll moved that said resolution and order be adopted, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilson and, upon said motion being put to vote, the following vote was recorded:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Dale County Board of Education (herein called “the Board”), in the State of Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. *Findings.* Preliminary to the adoption of this resolution, the Board has caused an investigation to be made of the facts set out in the following statements and, on the basis thereof, the Board has found and does hereby declare as follows:

(a) Dale County (herein called “the County”) is currently levying a special district tax for public school purposes at the rate of 4 mills on each dollar (forty cents on each one hundred dollars) of the assessed value of taxable property in the special school district in the County known as the Dale County School District (herein called “the District”) and consisting of all the area of the entirety of Dale County, Alabama, excluding the corporate limits of the City of Daleville, Alabama, the City of Ozark, Alabama, the City of Enterprise, Alabama, and the City of Dothan, Alabama which special district tax has been authorized by the electors of the District to be levied annually until and including the levy for the tax year that will begin October 1, 2021 (for which tax year the tax will become due and payable on October 1, 2022), being the tax that was originally authorized and provided for in Section 2 of Amendment No. 3 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 and the rate of which was heretofore increased pursuant to proceedings taken under the said Constitution, and that is being levied pursuant to an election held on January 14, 1992.

(b) All of the area lying within the Dale County School District is subject to the jurisdiction and control of the Board.

(c) The Board has further determined that it is necessary and desirable that the said special 4-mill district tax now being levied in the District be renewed and continued.

Section 2. *Petition to County Commission.* The Board does hereby respectfully petition and request the County Commission to call an election to be held on January 11th, 2022, in the District to determine whether or not a special district tax of forty cents on each one hundred dollars (four mills on each dollar) of the assessed value of the property subject to taxation in the District shall be levied annually for public school purposes within the District, which District includes all of the area lying within Dale County, Alabama, excluding the corporate limits of the City of Daleville, Alabama, the City of Ozark, Alabama, the City of Enterprise, Alabama and the City of Dothan, Alabama, for a period of twenty nine (29) consecutive years commencing with the tax year that will begin on October 1, 2022 (for which first tax year the tax will become due and payable on October 1, 2023); the said levy, if authorized, not to operate to increase the presently existing 4 mill district school tax in the District but to be in continuation of the 4-mill district school tax now levied in the District.

Section 3. *Delivery of Request.* The Secretary of the Board shall be and hereby is directed and instructed to prepare and deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the County Commission, accompanied by a written request that the said County Commission call the aforesaid election pursuant to the provisions of this resolution.”

(b) The Commission hereby further finds, determines and declares that said petition complies in all respects with the applicable provisions of Article 9 of Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the *Code of Alabama* (1975), and that the findings set out in Section 1 of the resolution adopted by the Board are true and correct.

Section 2. Call of Election. An election shall be and hereby is called to be held in the Dale County School District in the County (herein called "the District") on January 11, 2022, between the legal hours for holding elections and at the regular voting places in the District, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the District the question of whether the County shall be authorized to renew and continue the annual levy, for a period of twenty-nine (29) consecutive years beginning with the levy for the tax year that will begin on October 1, 2022 (for which first tax year taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2023), of a special ad valorem tax for public school purposes in the District at the rate of 4 mills on each dollar of the assessed value of the taxable property in said District, being the tax that was originally authorized and provided for in Section 2 of Amendment No. 3 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, and the rate of which was heretofore increased pursuant to proceedings taken under the said Constitution; it being intended that the said special tax to be voted on at the said election shall constitute a continuance and renewal of the said tax and shall not constitute an increase in the rate of taxation presently authorized in the District.

Section 3. Voting Places. The said election herein called shall be held and conducted at the regularly established voting places in the Dale County School District except as to the casting of ballots of absent voters as hereinafter provided.

Section 4. Notice of Election. The sheriff of the County is hereby directed to give notice of said election in the manner prescribed by law, by publication in *The Southern Star*, a newspaper published in the County and having general circulation in the Dale County School District, once a week for four consecutive weeks prior to the date fixed for said election, the first publication of such notice to be at least thirty days before the date of the said election, and also by posting a written notice of said election at three public areas within the Dale County School District, each of which shall be posted not less than thirty days prior to the date fixed for said election. The said notice to be so published and posted shall be in substantially the following form:
