#### Job Summary

Supervises the Litter Crew on County roads. The nature of the work performed requires that an employee in this class establish and maintain effective working relationships with other County personnel, Alabama Department of Corrections personnel, Work Release Inmates, and the general public.

#### Duties and Responsibilities

Places signs where needed to maintain safe work zones for litter pickup. Maintains responsibility for assigned vehicle, including maintaining an awareness of all activity around the equipment and practicing defensive driving when in pedestrian and vehicle traffic. Provides needed information and demonstrations concerning how to perform certain work tasks to work release inmates.

Transports work release inmates to and from work camp each day.

Supervises, and assists with litter and trash removal and disposal from Dale County roadsides and other locations, as directed.

Hauls litter to solid waste disposal facility on Bivens Road.

Keeps immediate supervisor, County Engineer, and designated others fully and accurately informed concerning work progress, including present and potential work problems and suggestions for new or improved ways of addressing such problems.

Attends meetings, conferences, workshops and training sessions and reviews publications and audio-visual materials to become and remain current on the principles, practices and new developments in assigned work areas. Receives training from Alabama Department of Corrections. Respond to citizens' questions and comments in a courteous and timely manner.

Other duties as required.
